

## ANNUAL REPORT

Dear Members,

The managing committee of your society is pleased to present its Annual Report along with the Statement of Accounts on the working of the society for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> march 2010.

4 meetings of the managing committee were held during the year where different inputs were imparted.

## Programme:

In the Month of April – the accounts department was busy Finalising the accounts for audit, along with that we also had a Monitoring and Evaluation internal Audit undertaken with support from Mr. Ashish Mainkar and the Project Director initiated the lobbying with Government ministries as well as relationship building with Corporates was an ongoing process.

In May, we had a visit from Mr Paul Jansen – Program officer from Hivos as well as a strategy planning meeting was organized with Project Concern International and Partners In Development Initiative to write a proposal to USAID for trafficking on adolescent boys in trafficking.

We also undertook the process of contacting schools to market our "Feeling of Touch" program in Mumbai and Pune and meet up with 15 schools in that duration.

In June we had a team from Leaders Quest of 15 people visiting our organization for understanding our work and process of working with Homosexual and Male sex workers community, simultaneously we were also trying to connect with Corporates to connect for supporting for Global forum

The work of Volunteers Advocacy trainings was ongoing with support from Adv Maharukh Adenwala, Soumya and Uma, along with Adv. Vinay Menon and Adv Shabnam Ansari.

We also organised a Media sensitisation workshop and invited imminent journalist and media professionals

July, we had a team and friends of Samabhavana to come together to plan the process of Astitva The Art Quake and support was invited after the conceptualized blue print was developed by the Project director, Ms Kunjan Mandke offered support of developing the website free cost and Mrs Ahs Arvind and Dr Geetha Mohan agreed to talk to sponsors for support, Jasmir Thakur took up the task of connecting with artists and getting the ground work finalized which went on till October

We also initiated a action research study with Grouppe Developpment (GD) - France based agency with office in Kolkatta for study on Adolescent boys in sex work, the tools though developed could not take off on time due to lack of key personnel support from GD and the project got shelved in December

We also got a Pilot project from LOVE 146.ORG- A USA based organization to support soft skills and vocational training for 52 boys which we completed in March, 2010


