

# ANNUAL REPORT

Dear Members,

The managing committee of your society is pleased to present its Annual Report along with the Statement of Accounts on the working of the society for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> march 2012.

4 meetings of the managing committee were held during the year where different inputs were imparted.

The year's scenario and its activities are listed below:

#### **Programme:**

In the Month of April – the accounts department was busy finalising the accounts for audit.

The work of Volunteers Health & Advocacy trainings was ongoing with support from with DR. Prachi Bedekar , Adv. Vinay Menon and Adv Shabnam Kazi.

The advocacy volunteer trainings are conducted at regular intervals (10 sessions) but the participants are not constant as most of them keep travelling due to work and as per the revised pedagogy of two hours, we are only offering basic important information that could be used to reduce violence on street from law enforcement agencies, especially during red alert periods and keeping in mind the latest judgment from Delhi High Court on IPC Section -377, as well as the sexual assault bill, the technicality of the law is being explained.

Volunteer's trainings were ongoing and also made available more branches of Bank of Maharashtra for account opening in Mumbai and we were also able to with our persistent advocacy with Bank of Maharashtra get a branch open in Mathura





The Youth Power program connected 3000 students.

21 colleges across Mumbai and Pune



Under the Youth Power program, we conducted the event of Balkalakaar from November 20<sup>th</sup> to 10 Dec 2011, in collaboration with AIESEC Mumbai and reached out 1000 BMC school children in 10 schools of E ward.

Samabhavana Society conducts various activities with its communities through its outreach program.




The eagle's eye view statistics of work done by us over the year April 2011- March 2012.
